



Algonquin Land Claim enviro-report up for comment

In October 2016, the Government of Canada, the Government of Ontario and the Algonquins of Ontario announced the signing of the Agreement-in-Principle (AIP) for the Algonquin Land Claim.

Approximately 117,500 acres of provincial lands are proposed to be transferred to the Algonquins of Ontario through the Algonquin Land Claim. The MNRF has drafted a report to assess the potential environmental effects of Crown land being transferred in the settlement.

The report covers the effects to access, industries, public utilities and businesses, recreational uses, adjacent land uses, the natural environment and culture.

If you fish, hunt or trap in the claim area, then we encourage you to provide feedback on this report, particularly as it relates to your interests.

The OFAH has been involved with the Algonquin Land Claim discussions for more than two decades, and will continue to remain involved to ensure that the final treaty reflects the interests of anglers and hunters to the greatest extent possible.
